

In the days after the shipwreck, the ship's furnishings and fittings were rowed to land in fishing boats and sold at a number of major auctions. The numerous amount of fine furniture and other fittings were thus scattered over a large part of West Jutland. Many of these objects, including the ship's anchor, were part of a joint exhibition by the Kystcentret Thyboron and the Lemvig Museum that opened in June 2006.




