Clivette "was working our kindred theories." Elizabeth Luther Cary wrote in the New York Times, that "Clivette was the forerunner of Soutine." In the instantaneous

expression evinced on paper or on canvas Clivette presages the abstract art movement that would not blaze in Manhattan until after WWII.
